For this performance, Mr. Rutz has the pleasure of being joined by Margaret Goodwin and Kasey Berger.

Drew Rutz retired in 2016 after 21 years as Music Director at St. Mary's Church in Port Washington. His career has spanned 49 years, 3 states, and 10 parishes. Now finding time to read many of the books he has collected, he continues to teach, practice and perform, and has finally begun to learn Hebrew 30 years after acquiring *Biblia Hebraica*.

Margaret Goodwin is a recent graduate of Ripon College, where she earned Bachelor's degrees in Music Performance and Biology. While at Ripon, she also participated in the Choral Union and Chamber Singers ensembles. She has been a part of nineteen musicals through the Port Washington theater program, and has participated in many honors choir programs and festivals in high school and college. She was also accepted into the Sound of America International European tour as a chorus member in 2014. Margaret is singing in the Bel Canto and Milwaukee Symphony Choruses for the 2018-2019 season, and loves to play piano in her spare time.

Kasey Berger is a recent graduate of the University of Wisconsin-Eau Claire. She received a Bachelor's degree in Materials Science and minored in Music. During her time at Eau Claire, Kasey participated in a variety of choral and instrumental ensembles, including the Women's Concert Chorale, the Symphonic Choir, and the Blugold Marching Band, where she played clarinet. She also performed in the university's production of Sweeney Todd in 2017.
